The author's name, school, teacher's name and school's address must appear on the back of each essay.

All entries must be mailed to North Dakota League of Cities (410 East Front Ave., Bismarck, ND 58504) and postmarked no later than March 14, 2016.

The essay winner will be announced during City Government Week April 4-8. The essay winner will receive a \$100 prize from the League and the winning essay will be published in the June issue of *CITYScan*.
